

### Voting on Proposed Amendments to the MOCA (QLD)Inc. Constitution

Based on the 'Yes' Vote to the 'Special Resolution' which was passed at the General Meeting held on 23 May 2018, the Final 3 Proposed Amendments to the MOCA(Qld)Inc. Constitution are published for consideration by all members.

Also included is the Voting Form to be used. All votes must be in the hands of the Returning Officer by 3PM on 20 July 2018.

#### Proposed Amendment 1

#### 4. CLASSES OF MEMBERS

- (a) The membership of the Association shall consist of three Classes of members described as:
  - (i) Ordinary Members,
  - (ii) Honorary Members, and
  - (iii) Life Members.
- (b) 'Ordinary Members' are persons who are over the age of eighteen years who are owners of a Ford Mustang motor vehicle and based on the personal information available to them have been considered and accepted for membership by a meeting of the Management Committee.
- (c) The number of Ordinary Members shall be unlimited and such membership shall be governed as prescribed in Paragraphs 5 to 10 of these Rules.

#### **Proposed Amendment 2**

### 11. HONORARY MEMBERS

- (a) 'Honorary Members' are those who no longer satisfy the criteria of Ordinary Member but have provided significant contribution to the Club and continue to do so.
- (b) The number of Honorary Members shall not exceed the number of 5% of total Ordinary Members.
- (c) <u>Nominations for Honorary Membership</u>. Every nomination must be made in writing to the Secretary of the Club and signed by both the Nominator and the Nominee. Such nominations may only be made by a current financial Ordinary Member.
- (d) Membership Limitations. Honorary Members are required to conform to all normal rules of the Club. Additionally, in accordance with the Queensland Liquor Act 1992 and the Association Incorporation Act1981, Honorary Members are not eligible to serve in a Management Committee role however they may hold lesser appointments but are not allowed Voting Rights at meetings. Honorary Members will not be required to pay Membership Fees.
- (e) Approval Process. Nominations received by the Secretary are to be vetted for suitability at a meeting of the Management Committee. Nominations considered suitable are then presented at a General Meeting and 'Approval' based on a majority vote by the members present. Nominees, whether successful or not, are to be notified in writing by the Secretary. Successful nominations should normally be based on a nominee having contributed significantly to the club over a period of years, including having served in club appointments. Other approval criteria may include individuals who have assisted the club by providing sponsorships and consideration may be given to Ordinary Members who for reasons of age or ill health can no longer satisfy the requirements of that Class of Member.
- (f) <u>Annual Review.</u> <u>All</u> Honorary Members positions are to be reviewed annually as an Item of Business following the election of the new committee at the Annual General Meeting. Notwithstanding the annual

review, an Honorary Member can have such membership terminated at any time should the Management Committee deem that some action or activity reflects negatively on the club. When a membership is terminated during the review process the member is to be notified in writing by the Secretary.

- (g) <u>Member Register.</u> Honorary Members will retain their same Member Number in the Member Register; however, it is to be suffixed with the letter 'H".
- (h) <u>Right of Appeal.</u> An Honorary Member or Applicant does not have the right of appeal for rejection of an application or termination of Member status.

### **Proposed Amendment 3**

#### 12. LIFE MEMBERS

- (a) <u>Life Member Eligibility</u>. Any current Member of the Club, may be elevated to or offered Life Member status by the Management Committee at any time and ratified by a ¾ majority vote at a General Meeting, provided that member meets the following criteria:
  - (i) They are classified as Founding Members of the Mustang Owners Club and they contributed to the establishment of the Club during its inaugural year of operation from 4 March 1980 to 4 March 1981, or
  - (ii) They have served a minimum of 30 Years <u>continuous</u> membership, which has included a minimum of 3 Terms of Office on the Management Committee. A 'Term of Office' is defined as 12 Calendar Months, the period between elections at the Annual General Meetings, or
  - (iii) They have served a minimum of 30 Years <u>continuous</u> membership including a minimum of 5 Terms of Office in an elected Non-Management Committee role. Consideration may also be given to such members who have contributed significantly to the planning, co-ordination and conduct of major events, e.g., State or National Concours.
- (b) Life Members have equal rights and obligations as they apply to Ordinary Members.
- (c) Life Members will retain their same Member Number in the Member Register; however, it is to be suffixed with the letter 'L".



### My Car - An Expose by Les Nye

My car as everyone knows is a 1968 Right Hand Drive Convertible. Yes, quite right now, but it didn't start life like that.

It was built in San Jose as a Coupe (left hand drive of course). At some stage of its life it had its guards flared as per Cobra Racing Mustangs of the day to enable wide tyres to be fitted and it was raced until it was crashed. It was then remodelled as a right hand driver convertible.

When you read the following details you could call it a "Bitzer". We believe it was raced here in Australia as a lot of the modifications came from Falcons of the day.

It has a XY Falcon radiator fitted and no expansion tank (I fitted one later). Hence its ability to Cruise in the Cooly's Street Parade at walking pace without over heating.

Down beside the Radiator is some wiring and a orange light that glows when the ignition is turned on.

It had no power steering and a Racing Steering wheel when I bought it. It had a spare steering wheel with it, (a Mustang one but no the usual Mustang type). I have fitted power steering and put back the original steering wheel. The front suspensions XW Falcon with updated Kelsey Hays brakes and we found the rear foot brake did not work because a ball bearing had been placed in the "T" brake line junction above the diff to allow Heel and Toe gear changes while racing.

Speaking of Diffs it's a "86" Ford Galaxy (more racing heritage). The original Motor we believe was taken out and a racing unit put back in. When it was remade after the crash the original motor was put back in.

I have since put extractors on it as the rest of the exhaust system its free flow. The suspension is very much upgraded as it goes around corners like it's sitting on rails with no body roll what so ever and I haven't the courage to find its limits.

It has a second chassis fitted to it, its bolted onto the original one, which we presume was a requirement by the Transport department to pass safety requirements after the mods.

There are two compliance plates on the suspension tower. One for the left to right steering conversion, the other for the Coupe to Convertible conversion. Speaking of which, when the roof is up (it's a manual one), it is quite different too the standard 68 convertible one.

The motor according to the badges is a 289 Windsor, wrong it's a 3012 Windsor. I was told it was a 289 with 3012 unleaded heads fitted, again wrong, according to the experts, it's a complete 302 Windsor. So there you have it. A trivia note in passing is that it has been around Bathurst but we think as a convertible with racing drivers sitting in the back. Well, thats about it, apart from the fact that being on a pension with little money restricts the amount of times and mileage I can run it which is a bugger (may have to sell her at a later-date) But I will continue to enjoy it as long as I can.
