I read an article from Europe where the emission laws are to change and the current emission exclusions on older "historical cars", yes all of them from Karl Benz 1886 Motorwagen onwards will no longer apply. Unless they pass current emission controls these cars will not be allowed to run on public roads. I just hope our legislators do not get that enthusiastic.



One of the questions I get asked frequently is "who can I take my car to have the upholstery replaced or who can fix: brakes, steering and the list goes on." They are coming to MOCA either due to a bad experience or they just don't know where to get quality repairs carried out to their mustang. This request brings up a dilemma, if we as MOCA develop a list of tradespeople who have done a great job for one or more of the members and then does a less than perfect job for someone who has used them after reading our list, we may be liable as we recommended them. But if we don't help fellow Mustang owners, we are not living up to the club's ideals.

One way of managing this would be to have the list drawn up along with a disclaimer, (the words need improving) pointing out that MOCA does not carry responsibility for the quality of the work of the tradespeople listed. It is totally the responsibility of the person using the service to satisfy themselves with the quality and reliability of the provided service.

The Trades listed can advertise in the magazine if they wish, but if a valid complaint is put forward that Trade will be removed from the list. The Management Committee has control of the list.


Thanks, Neil, for all you do with the runs, we understand and know what the runs entail, let's hope you keep getting some more help.

MOCA NATIONALS 2020 – PAINTED SILOS RUN TO ADELAIDE

Sunday 5th April to Sunday 19th April 2020

Come and join the fun participating in a 15 day (14 night) roadtrip to Adelaide and back for the 2020 Mustang Nationals.

We will visit many smaller country towns along the way and admire their local artwork adorning water tanks, silos and some buildings. We even get to a lap of Mount Panorama on our return leg. Speed limit is strictly 60 kph or risk significant contribution to the NSW Govt. We will also check out the museum at Murray's Corner.

We travel through 4 states covering on average 450km per travel day. The journey to Glenelg will take 5 days, with 4 days in Glenelg followed by a 6 day return. The complete roadtrip will add a little more than 5000km to your pony's odometer.

Accommodation whilst travelling will be on average around \$120 per night. This doesn't include accommodation for Glenelg as that is booked separately through the South Australian club. 10 queen rooms have been held at each overnight stop, multiple bed rooms are available just let me know what you require when confirming your attendence.
