From the President,

Hello to you, well even though we have been stuck at home not using our great cars the management committee has been very busy with emails and phone hook ups.

So, what has happened?


- After a huge amount of discussion and deliberation that involved the 2021
 Nationals committee, the Club management committee, our National
 delegates, the National President and some of our major sponsors. We have,
 with regret had to advise the MOCA National executive that MOCA
 Queensland would not be in a position to host the 2021 National
 Concours in Queensland.
- Why is this, well there are a number of factors that come in to play,
 - To have a successful concours 80% of the key events must be booked and virtually set in stone a year in advance. The remaining items must be locked in by September or October at the latest.




- And finally, there is just too much uncertainty at present as to what rules the government will have in place regarding meetings of large group until a vaccine is found for Covid-19.
- The Management committee has decided that we will hold a State concours in 2021, this will either be in September or October 2021. This will be a one-day event, that is much easier to organise, if there are willing helpers, and is in the outdoors so should be in line with any regulations the government has in place at that time.
- We have taken advantage of the good prices and tradespeople looking for work and are taking steps to
 upgrade the AC in the club rooms. We have decided to install two units, one at each end of the building.
 This should be a boon for those members who like the bar end of the club room.
- There are two more projects that we have yet to tackle:
 - The "upgrade" of the sewage system, the system we have is a constant source of problems. Unfortunately, there are no registered plans of where the pipes run. Our tame plumber wants to dig up the downstairs floor and send a camera down the pipe to find the restriction so it can be cleared. I have also raised this matter with council as they theoretically "own" the sewage pipes we hook up to. They have said they want to look into it, "Not mirrors" I hope. This project is on hold, waiting to see if council does anything.
 - The other project is the two dead trees in the car park, I have asked council to make them safe. The last thing we want is a branch to suddenly fall onto a Mustang or even a person. We have formally raised this with the tree owners, the council, so now we wait.
- In closing we are looking at the feasibility of holding a **non-contact run** in early June. The details are in the magazine, please ensure you follow the Covid-19 rules for this run otherwise as well as a fine for you we may see further restrictions placed on this type of event.

MEMBER PROFILE: Tony and Jean Vincent

After 36 years of marriage and shoving car mags depicting Mustangs for sale under my nose, I used the Nike phrase out loud, very loud, "Just Do It". There has to be some way of getting a peaceful life! So, we did it. After probably six months of seriously looking for a 1966 Ford Mustang Coupe - it just had to be a 1966 Coupe - we found the 'one' not too far from home on the Gold Coast. It was a Vintage Burgundy 1966 Ford Mustang Coupe with a 289 Windsor engine. There were some mods to the car to bring it up to GT standard but otherwise pretty standard and in great condition. Not perfect as, MOTH (man of the house) wanted to still be able to tinker and add to the car. That was in 2010, 10 years ago.



The next step in the 'Mustang Dream' was to join the Qld Mustang Owners Club. It was magic being greeted at our first meeting by Cheryll White, the incumbent run co-ordinator, who enthusiastically encouraged us to join in all the runs and everything in between. Robyn Noden was another standout for chatting to us and making us feel welcome. Gordy of course, was able to sort MOTH out with SIVS rego and provide great advice on many things.

Our first run dawned, excitement mounted. We met up at Shell Nudgee and how wonderful it was to be part of such a great convoy of Mustangs. There were some beauties and we felt privileged to be part of it. MOTH was beside himself, he had at long last realised his lifelong dream. The Mustangs rumbled north, and we were consumed by the sounds and coolers of about 20 magnificent machines.

2015 and the new Mustang was being imported into Australia. It was tempting and it was gorgeous, and I needed a new car. This time MOTH was the one to yell "Just Do it". And we did, we ordered a new Ruby Red GT. It was an almost 12 month agonizingly long wait. Ruby was delivered in September 2016 with a build date of July 2016. Our 1966 was built in July 1966 - exactly 50 years apart! We pinch ourselves each time we look at our 'his' and 'hers' ponies.



We love to mix with other Mustang owners and in fact all classic car enthusiasts. We participate in as many runs as family commitments allow and it's great to go to car shows and displays with our babies. Our greatest joy is when our Mustangs are instrumental in helping charities.



Vale Gale Halderman



Gale Halderman, an American designer who designed the first generation of the Mustang, the most famous of American muscle cars, died at the age of 87. The designer worked at Ford for over forty years. Strongly desired by manager Lee Iacocca, the Mustang was born in 1964 as a small and snappy sports car not too expensive. To define its style, Iacocca decided to organize an in-house design competition: out of the 24 projects submitted, Gale Halderman's was selected. After defining the main lines, Halderman followed the style of the Mustang up to production and was then responsible for the style of the sports car for another eight years.





The platform on which the first generation Mustang was based was the Ford Falcon. However, the chassis was completely revised to match the new car's characteristics. An innovative structural system was also added, called Torque Box, which allowed to increase the rigidity, solidity and handling of the car, compared to those of the time, facilitating at the same time its production. The very first concept of the car, called Ford Mustang I, was built in just 100 days and debuted on 7 October 1962, during the US GP at Watkins Glen (New York). Since 1964, the Ford Mustang has now reached the sixth generation unveiled in 2014.






