QHMC REPORT: Russell Whitney for John Greene – New Committee elected. SIV's log book for Queensland not being pursued at this stage.

MEMBERS PRESENT AT MEETING WITH BIRTHDAY THIS MONTH WERE GIVEN A FREE RAFFLE TICKET IN TONIGHTS RAFFLES: Stephen Foster, Georgina Elliot-Nelson, Dennis Freedman.

GENERAL BUSINESS:

- Secretary (Andrew White) will be confirming via email who has Club House keys.
- Chris Holst, advised that there had been communication regarding collecting funds for Club Run's. Funds had been sometimes collected via cash or deposited into a private account. It was brought to the Management Committees attention that in November 2014 it was voted on and passed that funds for runs and other activities would only be collected via the MOCA account, with this knowledge monies should only be collected via a MOCA bank account. It was noted that Bevin Dryden and Jack Hall questioned the need for collecting monies via the MOCA account. (Jack Hall moving to maintain current collections via current methods, however this motion could not proceed due to the decision made in November 2014 that funds be collected via MOCA bank account) Neil De San Miguel was asked for his feedback, advising he felt ok with either method, but concerned there would be extra work load, and that sometimes prepayment was required at some venues. Russell Whitney advised extra load would be minimal.

Solution proposed to comply with the November 2014 vote was to open a new account with two debit cards, one for the Run Coordinator and one for the President. This account would maintain only the minimum dollar amount to keep it open and funds would be deposited into it by members and a receipt would be issued via the Treasurer. Functions would then be paid via the Debit card at the venue or prior as required.

Andrew White advised that based on discussions with the Department of Fair Trading, funds not relating to the operation of the Incorporated Association did not have to be banked into the club bank account, hence it is believed that what we had been doing was not illegal. HOWEVER, the vote back in November 2014, changed the club rules, so that we had to bank funds via the MOCA bank account.

There was discussion between a number of members, including Sue Clarke, Margaret Moran, Bevan Dryden, Jack Hall, Andrew White, Jean Vincent, Ray Saunders, Chris Holst, Russell Whitney.

Motion: Chris Holst moved that the club open a new account with two debit cards as outlined above, Seconded by Sue Clarke. Vote taken: For: 37 Against: 1 Abstain: 7 Motion Passed.

 Jack Hall, discussed the new Mustang museum at Charlotte NC USA. Jack explained all the inclusions for membership as a Founding member – Banners, Plaque, Photo of club members, Passes, Listed in entry book. As MOCA Qld had already purchased a Brick for the same Museum, Martin Schmidt was asked for comment, and Martin thought it would be a positive idea. Cost is USD \$300 and then an annual fee if we wanted to continue, however the club would still be a founding member whether we continued membership or not.

Motion: Jack Hall moved that the MOCA Qld Club become a Foundation Member. Seconded by John Binge. Vote taken: For: 44 Against: 1 Abstain: 0 Motion Passed. Jack Hall will pay the fee and claim back on the club.

• Chris Holst reminded members of upcoming elections, in September and the importance of all the positions to the club. Chris encouraged members who had not held a position to nominate and "have a go". The key critical positions that must be filled are President, Treasurer and Secretary.
