DELEGATES REPORT March 2017 QTMR

Susan Osmon gave a talk on Road Safety

Between 2011 and 2015 265 people were killed and 2,808 were hospitalised due to drink driving.

In 2016 Qld Gov. and TMR are creating a discussion paper to target High Risk Drink Drivers, for the community to comment on by 7 March 2017.[missed it by that much]

Enhance the by current Alcohol Ignition Interlock Program by:-

a---increase the sit–out period from 2 to 5 years until they have an interlock fitted. \$4000.00

b---must demonstrate they have separated drinking from driving. Information downloaded from unit each month, so if they have a fail it will increase the time of lock out

d---expanded to include P plate drivers

e--- fitting lock to include photo ID.

Introduce Education, to educate first time drink drivers about alcohol consumption. Abolishing restricted licences, so they must serve the full time period.

New Red light cameras are incorporated with speed cameras to detail running red lights on amber.

If you captured an infringement on your dash and you wish to report it to POLICE LINK 131444 don't forget its your evidence and you must attend COURT with the police.

Brett Stevenson Q P S gave a talk on ANTI HOONING Law, and answered questions on the legislation.

IF you have to forfeit a car, it is now possible to take the matter to a COURT to be resolved. Forfeiture of vehicles is not common. Sharyn Littler asked if driving uncertified vehicles could be removed from the type offences?



That night there were eight Mustang owners present... Positive vibes and another meeting planned for the following month. First meetings were held at Geoff and Carole's house, then a couple at a coffee shop over the road from Boggo Road Jail, then the Teachers building at Spring Hill. BY July we had seventeen members and all was progressing well.

We made contact with the South Australian Club and the Victorian Club. At Easter 1981 the Victorian Club hosted the First National Meeting and Concours at Swan Hill. It was a real eye opener as previous to this I had raced my car at hillclimbs and cleaning them up for a concours was a different story to racing, (No, not racing the Mustang). Ours was the only entrant at Swan Hill from the Queensland Club.

Easter 1982 saw the Queensland Club host the Nationals at Acacia Ridge Hotel, a huge and successful event.

The Queensland Club had grown, likewise the Clubs in other States around Australia.

Actually the first Club meeting I was absent from was October 1988 when I went to Long Beach California and bought and imported Seven Mustangs and a 1963 Buick Riviera and put a deposit on the 1968 Shelby Convertible.

So the Queensland Mustang Owners Club has it's 37th Anniversary on the 4th March 2017.




