#### **INWARD CORRESPONDENCE:**

He advised that one vendor pledged \$8000 to be at the Concours and the other committed to a percentage of sales. EC advised he saw the Concours as an opportunity to incorporate an American car show, Show and Shine and envisaged that it could become an annual event with potential to grow it over the coming years.

EC spoke in general terms about Motofest and how the new marquee drew the attention of a lot of people. DLK commented it made the Club look very professional and was an easy way to promote the Club.
