The President's Report

Wow these past 3 months have flown by.

Since our state concurs at Manly back in March, both Monique and I have been on the road for a 4.5 week 7,200km caravan trip that included towing our 21ft monster in a loop from Brisbane down the coast road to Lakes Entrance, across Victoria in to Adelaide for the 2023 Mustang Nationals then through the Barossa and back up the inland road through Broken Hill, Burke, Lightning Ridge, Nindigully, Goondiwindi and back into Brisbane. All I want to do is go again, but in the opposite direction, up north.

The Mustang Nationals in Adelaide over Easter was fantastic, it was a real credit to Tony and Trish Kilvington and the rest of the SA MOCA Team. Upon my enquiry with Tony a team of up to 30 people was needed to pull off this well-organized event. It proved to me the concept of a Mustang Nationals event was more than just another car show event, it is that and a whole lot more. For one thing, it was a fantastic opportunity to gather fellow likeminded members from across other parts of the country and bring them together, to enjoy a weekend which included 3 dinner events and several day activities. This is truly a great overall event, but it also drove home some home truths about our state here in Queensland lacking the needed capabilities of hosting a similar event in 2024.

It was only after getting back and discussing it over two general meetings and then our Management Committee meeting, we realized there were just too many variables that could negatively impact us hosting the National event. So we should just focus on our own State Event – but Just to name a few of those issues :

1. Lack of willing members in organizing things in the leading up and on the weekend itself – a team of up to 25 – 30 people are needed – currently we only had about only 10 people committed.
2. Lack of Qld Judges to assist – we are aware several qualified people may also be considering going to the USA 60th on the same weekend. This would have then been left up to available National Judges that may or may not have been available.
3. Some financial risk – albeit I felt that could have been managed to derive an OK outcome.
4. General lack of participation from the QLD membership base to fill current existing club positions which leaves an enormous amount of work on to the current Executive Committee to complete.

Moreover, all of the current Executive Committee members are standing down the September at the next AGM and none of us are able to e-nominate for any positions due to either poor health issues or just being too busy running our own businesses. So, the club will need a whole new committee to maintain the existence of the Qld MOCA club. The current Executive Committee are desperately trying to streamline several things that we believe will make it a lot easier for the next in coming committee, but there is only so much we can do in the next 3 months.

We sincerely hope that some “New” people will consider stepping forward to take on the vacant roles within the Executive Committee and other important club positions, otherwise we will not have a club post September. The fact is, our club is an Incorporated club, which means we must abide by the Qld Incorporations Act and therefore, it is legally incumbent on the club to fill those positions in order for the club to continue operating. Failure to have those Executive Committee positions filled, means that the existing committee, must shut down the club within a short time period and disburse any existing money held by the club to other likeminded Queensland Incorporated clubs. We obviously do not want that to happen, but if a few people don't step forward we won't have any other choice. please make yourself known to us, if you feel you can take on a position and we can discuss this with you prior to the AGM in September.

Queensland SIVs Guidelines

As a part of the Mustang Owners Club of Qld, many members avail of 'club registration' As part of this you agree to the Qld Transport terms and conditions for the registration and operation of a Special Interest Vehicle. Operating outside the approved usage may very well mean that you are uninsured and liable in the event of an accident.

CONDITIONS AND RESTRICTIONS;

A special interest vehicle must not be used for:

- General purposes - for example, to commute to and from the registered operators place of employment, running down to the shops, and other forms of everyday vehicle use.
- For hire or reward - a fee cannot be charged for use of the vehicle, and the owner cannot receive any consideration or reward for supplying the vehicle.

You and anyone driving your special interest vehicle must only use the vehicle for:

- participating in rallies or events, including impromptu events organised by an incorporated vehicle club or events sanctioned by the Australia Street Rod Federation (ASRF).

□ a rally is a social event where a parade of special interest vehicles travel together for competition or to meet at an agreed location. Rallies and events must be listed in the incorporated club newsletter or on the incorporated club's website or social media page (or in another manner approved by the club or ASRF, such as the club calendar of events) prior to the event.

□ an impromptu event is an event that has been initiated by a club member, involves one or more vehicles, and must comply with the following elements:

- involves an invitation to wider club members to attend the event; and is either
- endorsed in advance of the event by the relevant club or ASRF committee; or,
- where it exists, complies with published club guidelines as to what is a valid event; and

□ is listed wither in the newsletter, on the website, or social media page (or in another manner approved by the club or ASRF, such as the club calendar of events) prior to the event.

Note: Incorporated vehicle clubs should maintain a register of endorsed impromptu events. This register should contain information on the impromptu event.

□ participating in processions for which a Special Events Permit has been issued under the Transport Operations (Road Use Management –Accreditation and Other Provisions) Regulation 2015

□ exhibiting the vehicle in displays, fetes or similar functions conducted for religious, charitable or educational purposes ceremonial purposes (such as weddings, formals, funerals) involving immediate and de facto family members, or as part of a sanctioned incorporated club event, provided this is not done for fee or reward. Immediate and de facto family means parents, grandparents, sons, daughters, grandchildren, adopted children and adopted grandchildren, but not extended family members such as aunts, uncles, nephews and nieces

□ preparing for, proceeding to, and returning from the above activities

□ direct travel to and from an approved inspection station to get a safety certificate or certificate of inspection before offering the vehicle for sale travel in order to have the vehicle repaired. There is no distance restriction, however, such travel must be reasonable and justifiable by the vehicle operator road testing within a 15km radius from the place where the vehicle is garaged or is being repaired. The purpose of the travel must be to road test the vehicle following repair or restoration, or for general vehicle maintenance and not for any other purpose. This does not include use as an everyday means of transport. A passenger may travel in your vehicle to assist with road testing—only if your vehicle can legally carry passengers.

Some Points Relating to SIVs

Club Membership is MANDATORY

There is now a legal requirement to maintain membership of at least one club to have SIVs registration or use a SIVs registered vehicle. Penalties now apply and the SIVS REGISTRATION MUST BE SURRENDERED if membership lapses.

The obligation is on owners, NOT clubs to ensure continuing membership. Clubs are not asked to retain dating certificates, only the owner.

SIVs REGISTRATION is covered by two websites;

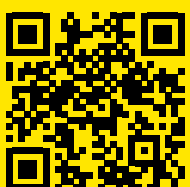

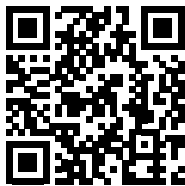
