From my years at MOCA there were members interested in doing track events in some form and with this in mind HRCC were looking to see if any members both classic and modern in participating in Timed Trials events at Morgan Park - Warwick or QR Ipswich.

Timed Trials is the new name for regularity and is a speed event not Racing. Hence in short nominate a lap time and endeavour to maintain this time each lap over 6-8 laps.

You are competing against yourself based on you nominated time.

So there is no confusion a minimum of S2 Motor Sport Australia Licence is required and at least an approved helmet and the car will **NOT** be insured while on the race track.

Events are over 2 or 3 days with approx. 5 runs over the weekend.

Our first event this year is TTT.....Try Test and Tune at Morgan Park in February, which is a none competitive weekend for testing, tuning and allowing newbies to see if they are interested.
