Friday 9th April – Welcome Meet & Greet

This meet & greet event is being held at the Wangaratta Performing Arts & Convention Centre on the corners of Ford & Ovens Streets, Wangaratta which is a short 500m stroll from main accommodation locations. For those wishing to drive there is ample on/off street parking located nearby this venue.

DAYTIME EVENTS:

Saturday 10th April

Breakfast & Mustang P-51 Photo opportunity

Enjoy a country cooked breakfast by the local Wangaratta Lions club while having the opportunity have your car photographed in front of a fully operating Mustang P-51 warplane.

Located 15 minutes from Wangaratta the local airfield on Greta Rd makes a great backdrop for your photo. Each paying entrant will have the opportunity to position their car in front of the plane and 3 cameras will take simultaneous photos of the entrants in their vehicles. A total of 6 photos will form part of the package.

Attendees will be responsible for the cost of their own breakfast.

Cruising Trip

Following breakfast for those wishing to explore the country side in their Mustang there is an escorted cruise available.

King Valley Prosecco Road

A leisurely 2 -3 hour return trip will see you travel through the picturesque King Valley, now very much a foodie's paradise. MUSTANG CONCOURS JUDGING:

Saturday 10th April

Judging will be at Ovens Ford located at 62-66 Parfitt Rd, Wangaratta, about a 5 mins drive from accommodation venues. Concours Judging – Thoroughbred, Original & Modified Classes including Resto modified.

Access to judging area for Concours entrants is via concrete driveway with gravel / screening entry ramps from the side street.

Ovens Ford have granted us full access to their workshop for the judging to be undertaken in but access to this area by the general public is restricted.

By all means come down and view the cars before and after they are judged as a coffee and food vendor will be onsite.

You may even be tempted to purchase one of the many cars that Ovens Ford has for sale as the showroom is open for business as usual.

NB: Concours entered cars will also be required to be displayed on Sunday.



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MUSTANG NATIONALS DISPLAY – SHOW & SHINE

Sunday 11th April

The Nationals 2027 display will be held at Apex Park 14 Clements St, Wangaratta which is centrally located in the township with plenty of parking within walking distance for non Mustang vehicles.

Apex Park is a large grassed area for cars to be displayed on has a extensive covered area, onsite toilets and kids play area.

This is also when the Judging for the Display Judged class will occur.

Entry Fee applies for ALL Mustangs parked on site.

Display Non-judged Mustangs is \$20.00 per car and we encourage pre payment. (see registration form)

A large selection of food and drink vendors will be to on hand to feed the masses with trade stands also selling their wares.
