- The issue of a Yearbook has been raised at previous meetings, with executive asked to obtain costings to produce a "magazine quality" document that would contain the years articles, trip reports and the like. A quote was obtained of \$4500 to produce 200 magazines, full colour, lightweight gloss paper with cover of around 100 pages. (ie similar specs to a typical commercial magazine) This equates to around \$22.50 plus postage and handling for a total cost of around \$27ea. Consensus was that is too expensive to print the same material that has already been published and distributed in the e-mag throughout the year. Editor has previously indicated that

she does not have time to collate articles, format, prepare document for printing, send to and collect from printers, then put in envelope and mail as she works away. (She is happy to continue with the emag as she can do that whilst away). Some discussion was held if it could be produced "not too expensive" then it could be viable. Several people indicated they were not interested in receiving a hardcopy version of already read articles.

Andrew New offered to obtain another quote for a less pages, non glossy yearbook.

Two motions were then put forward for resolution at the AGM
