Summary given of new laws key issue you can use vehicle for test or take to repairer without permission if less than 30km from home otherwise use email registration of use. If formally registered

then no requirement for pit inspection. Must be financial member otherwise use on road is illegal. Ie pay subscriptions before 30 June. See Mick Muggeridge if you need further details. Issue raised of situation if you die and partner wants to use the vehicle for funeral then not registered.
