Concessional Licensing

Meeting held 28 November at Jaguar Club Rooms. Discussed the presentation.
Many clubs have been audited, with minor issues raised that needed to be rectified. Highlighted that it is the members' responsibility to keep records for two (2) years. It is a requirement that the run is logged before commencement. The name of the registered person must match the membership name and number. Membership to MOCWA costs \$70/year yet saves over \$600/car on concession.

Council of Motoring Car Clubs

Currently there are 98 clubs that are members of the CMC and 3 associated. There was a robust discussion about why this was being considered.
